Applicants must be one of the following.

- A member in good standing with the Enlisted Association, National Guard of Kentucky (EANGKY).
- A family member of a member in good standing with the Enlisted Association, National Guard of Kentucky (EANGKY).
- A spouse of a member in good standing with the Enlisted Association, National Guard of Kentucky (EANGKY).

Applicants must be enrolled as a student at an accredited College, University, or Trade School for the upcoming academic semester, trimester or quarter, or current high school senior.

Children of a deceased member in good standing at the time of passing are eligible to apply.

Financial need, as well as academic achievement, will be considered in the selection process. Receipt of other funds for college attendance does NOT exclude applicants, however this must be declared on the application.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate the applications, and will reserve the right to award the scholarship to whom they decide is most deserving.

Applicants must provide a copy of their high school transcript if they are just entering college. Students who have previously attended college must provide a college transcript.

To apply, students must complete the USAA / EANGKY Scholarship application form and submit all required documents on the EANGKY website at <u>https://eangky.org/scholarships/</u> by July 1st of each year.

ONLY ONLINE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

The applicants selected for a scholarship will be notified no later than January 01, 2024.

Those applicants selected for a scholarship will be presented with the scholarship at the Area II Mid-Winter Conference in Louisville, Ky.

Upon verification of enrollment, a check in the amount of the scholarship will be issued jointly to the student and the institution for the direct application toward school supplies, fees, and/or tuition.

If granted a scholarship and I fail to complete the school term for reasons other than sickness or physical injury, I agree to return any scholarship money received by me back to the EANGKY Scholarship Fund.
